[] Original Passport must accompany mares showing up to date flu/tet vaccination record within 6 months of arrival at the stud

For Mares which have been outside the UK & Ireland within the last 12 months, you will need in addition to the above:

[] Negative EVA Certificate taken within 28 days of arrival in UK, plus 2nd test to be taken 14 days after arrival at UK stud. Subsequent EVA's may be required dated within 30 days of covering.

[] Negative EIA Certificate taken within 14 days of arrival in mainland Britain. 2nd test to be taken 14 days after arrival at UK Stud and possible further EIA test to be taken within 21 days prior to covering.

(Any Mare arriving from ITALY or GERMANY with a foal at foot will require a blood test for EIA to be taken from the foal a minimum of 14 days after arrival in this country).

[] Negative CEM Endometrial (Cervical) Swab certificate taken during current oestrus cycle (Walk-in mares only – boarding mares will be tested at the stud before covering).

Copies of international travel documents should accompany the Mare when visiting the stallion stud. Please refer to the HBLB Code of Practice 2024 for further details.

This certificate must accompany the mare at the time of **EACH INDIVIDUAL COVERING** or **PREFERABLY** be faxed,

e-mailed or posted to the Stud Office **before the mare arrives.**
